## NC Cooperative Program Section:

- Gifts that negatively designate the Baptist State Convention of NC shall not be considered Cooperative Program gifts. Gifts which negatively designate the Southern Baptist Convention shall not be reported to the SBC as qualifying gifts for SBC messenger status, but will qualify the church for BSCNC cooperating status.
- Gifts for Mission:Dignity and Scholarship Support are not Cooperative Program funds. Mission:Dignity will be put in the reserve to assist retired NC Baptist pastors and surviving spouses through GuideStone's Mission:Dignity program. Scholarships will be put in scholarship endowment at the NC Baptist Foundation for Campbell and Gardner-Webb divinity schools.
- Additional information on exclusions:

Many churches have asked for more info about how to use the "exclusions" line on our remittance form to negatively designate certain ministries within the Cooperative Program budget. As you know, our financial policies allow a church to exclude up to 3 items in the budget and the gift still qualify as Cooperative Program receipts. However, there are limitations regarding what budget items can be excluded, so we're providing this explanation for you. Here's what you need to know:

- 1) You may only exclude items that are in OUR (Baptist State Convention) budget – that means you can exclude any institution or agency in our budget (Southern Baptist Convention, Biblical Recorder, Provision (formerly NC Baptist Foundation), Baptist Children's Home, etc.) but NOT a specific item in THEIR budget. So you cannot exclude a PART of the SBC budget, or Children's Homes budget – i.e. you cannot exclude NAMB, IMB, ERLC, a Seminary, or a particular residential home of the BCH, or the salaries of Provision employees, etc. We do not approve THEIR budgets – you can decide to exclude the whole entity, but not "parts" of those entities. If, for example, you write NAMB on the exclusions line, we will only convey to the SBC Executive Committee that a church indicated its desire to exclude NAMB from \$XXX dollars in Cooperative Program support, but it will be up to the SBC Executive Committee on how that is handled, and the gift from the church will be considered Cooperative Program giving without exclusions.
- 2) You may exclude Convention ministry items on the "Team" or "Group" level only. Therefore you could exclude "Church Planting" but not "Church Planting Staff Salaries"; or you could exclude "Mission Catalyts" but not "Region 4 Mission Catalyst"; or you could exclude "Operations Group" but not "Utilities".
- 3) Churches may exclude the Baptist State Convention as a whole, which means the entire gift will go to the Southern Baptist Convention; BUT those gifts do NOT qualify as Cooperative Program gifts – they will simply be considered designated gifts to the SBC.

**Our prayer is that fewer and fewer churches will use negative designations in the years to come (it represents only a few percent of our total receipts).** We allow it because we value church autonomy so greatly – but we also believe that it undermines a spirit of "Cooperation" as it relates to Southern Baptist Life. We accomplish SO much together and the Cooperative Program is still the most efficient and effective missions funding strategy in the world. The Kingdom grows when we focus on what we can agree to do together; it is stifled when we focus on the things about which we don't agree!
