Thank you for your prayers and gifts as we work toward this year's goal of \$2.8 million.

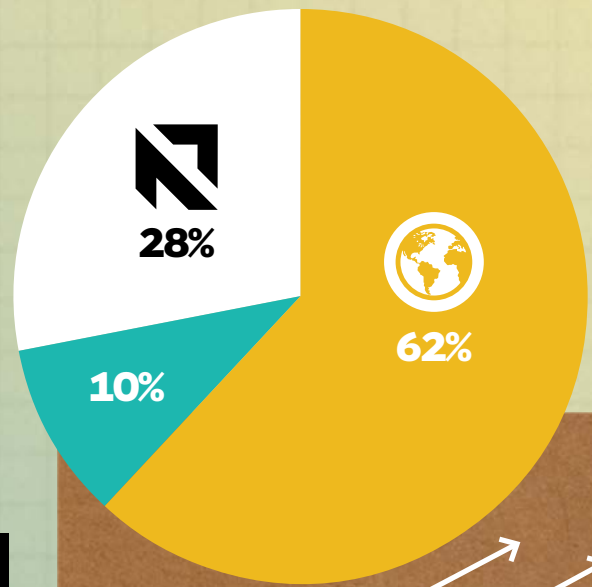

REBUILD CENTERS

Disaster rebuild centers are providing the vital infrastructure needed to sustain long-term recovery and hope across our state. Following the catastrophic impact of Hurricane Helene, five fully equipped rebuild centers in East Flat Rock, Swannanoa, Burnsville, Spruce Pine and Boone have successfully housed, fed, and deployed more than 30,000 volunteers.

As of May 2026, these teams have already completed 928 home rebuilds, with an additional 185 rebuilds and 24 new home constructions currently underway.

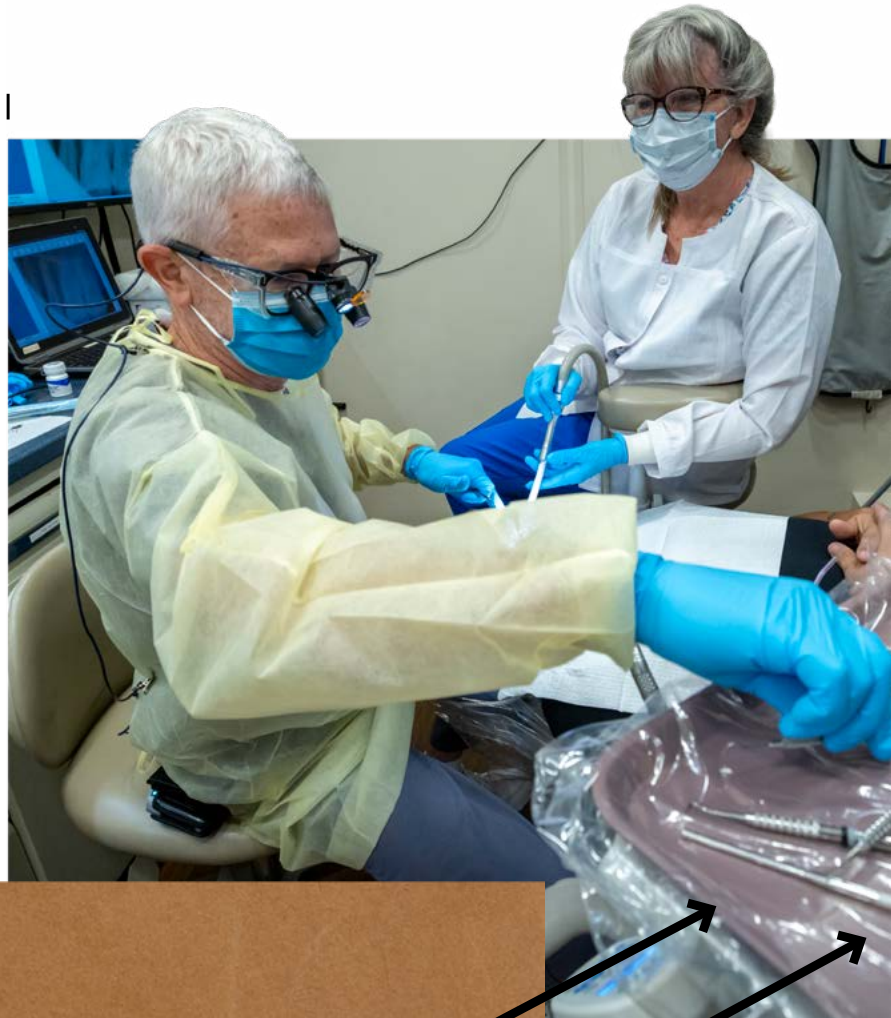
MEDICAL, DENTAL AND HEALTH SCREENING *Ministries*

Volunteers with medical, dental and health screening ministries live sent as the hands and feet of Jesus. A fleet of mobile medical, dental and health screening units offer free health services to underserved patients. The fleet is staffed by volunteer medical and dental professionals. Patients also hear the good news of Jesus Christ from pastors and volunteers who provide care.

MISSION CAMPS

Baptists on Mission operates mission camps in Red Springs, Shelby and Rose Hill that help churches get involved in missions. The camps host churches, youth groups and others and coordinate short-term missions projects in the local community. Volunteers engage in a variety of projects, such as construction, painting, home repair, yard work, Bible schools, sports camps and more.

A CHURCH PLANTING PARTNERSHIP



A partnership between N.C. Baptists and the North American Mission Board's Send Network, SendNC cultivates a church planting movement from the mountains to the coast. By equipping local churches to multiply, SendNC makes the love of Jesus known statewide. Endorsed planters receive essential coaching, training and financial support.

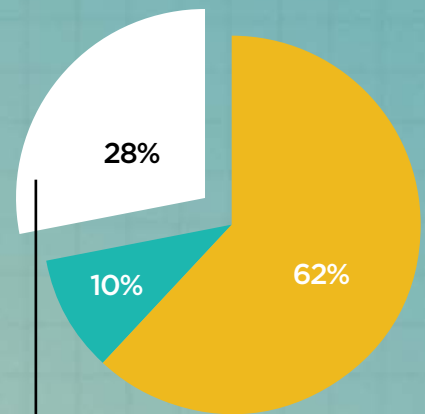
The NCMO helps fuel this effort, providing about one-third of SendNC's annual budget. This year, 28% of all NCMO gifts go directly toward establishing new churches in North Carolina.

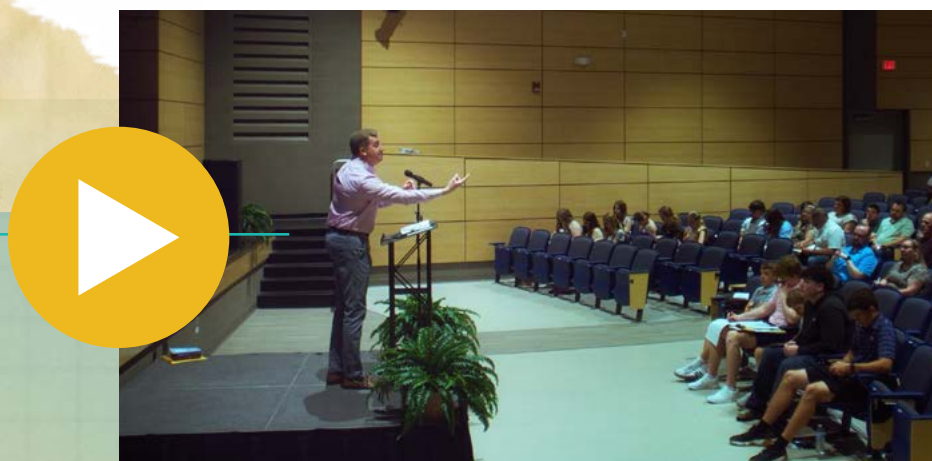


What's next for **SENDNC?**

In 2025, N.C. Baptists saw 36 church planters endorsed and 51 new churches join our movement of churches.

Statistics repeatedly demonstrate the need for widespread revitalization of existing churches. With approximately 3,300 Baptist churches in North Carolina, some may wonder why church plants are needed. However, new church plants are one of the most effective ways to reach new people with the gospel of Jesus Christ and to breathe new missional life into existing churches. Through SendNC church plants, 820 people followed the Lord through baptism. Strengthening existing churches should — and will — result in new churches. Our desire is to have every church rediscover the vision for church planting and multiplication.

God's plan for a church is multiplication. Since 2022, SendNC has seen 167 churches classified as Sending, Multiplying or Movement churches, meaning that their church has taken primary responsibility for a planter, raised up and sent people to begin a new N.C. Baptist church. SendNC continues to catalyze new sending churches and church-planting residencies in existing churches, hosting labs, workshops, trainings and church-planter assessment events.

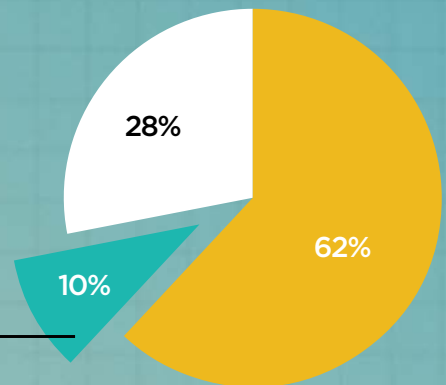


ASSOCIATIONS

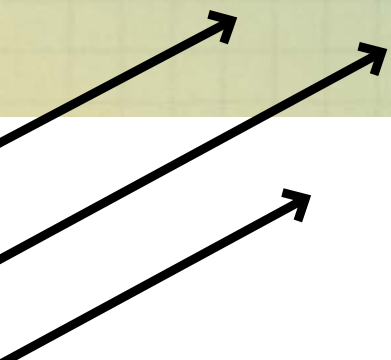

The month of September marks the primary emphasis for the North Carolina Missions Offering. Please join in a special prayer emphasis for NCMO and ministries it supports in the week leading into September. Following are some suggested daily prayer points for individuals and churches.

SUNDAY, AUG. 30

Baptists on Mission

Pray for the leaders of Baptists on Mission as they oversee 19 dynamic ministries. Ask God to use every project and partnership to make disciples and meet needs. Pray that churches would rise up and send volunteers ready to serve wherever God leads — locally, nationally and globally.

MONDAY, AUG. 31

Church Planters and Church Plants across North Carolina

Lift up church planters who are boldly planting gospel-centered churches across our state. Pray for encouragement, wisdom and fruitful ministry. Ask God to call new laborers to plant churches and serve unreached neighborhoods in North Carolina.

TUESDAY, SEPT. 1

Disaster Relief

Thank God for the men and women who respond when disasters strike. Pray for protection and strength as they provide hope and help in Jesus' name. Ask God to open hearts to the gospel through every act of service.

WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 2

Mission Camps in Red Springs and Shelby

Pray for the directors and volunteers at these mission camps. Ask God to bless their work as they serve residents in practical ways and point people to Christ.

THURSDAY, SEPT. 3

Church Planting Consultants

Lift up the church planting consultants who walk alongside planters in every step — recruiting, training, encouraging and resourcing. Ask the Lord to guide their efforts.

FRIDAY, SEPT. 4

Baptist Associations

Pray for associational leaders as they support and equip churches in their region. Ask God to give them vision and unity as they help congregations grow stronger, reach their communities and make disciples.

SATURDAY, SEPT. 5

Medical, Dental and Health Ministry

Praise God for the volunteers — medical professionals, pastors and counselors — who serve those in need through mobile clinics and screenings. Ask God to use these ministries to meet physical and spiritual needs. Pray for patients to experience the love of Christ through compassionate care.

SUNDAY, SEPT. 6

Church Planting among Internationals

Pray for God to raise up more workers for both local and global missions, and for more churches to actively serve their communities and send members to the nations. Ask Him to draw people to Jesus through the witness of churches, especially in culturally and ethnically diverse areas.
