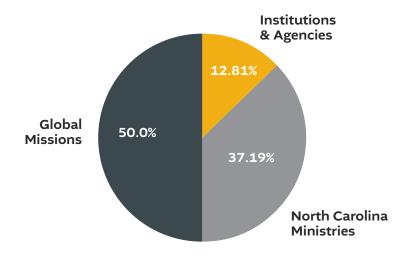

FROM THE EDT

N.C. BAPTISTS,

One of the important items of consideration during this year's annual meeting is our missions giving Cooperative Program budget proposal for 2024. Your convention board of directors unanimously endorsed a \$31 million budget proposal, which includes a 50/50 split of undesignated CP funds – an equal distribution between global ministry partners and state ministries.

This is a historic moment for N.C. Baptists. When the Cooperative Program was established in 1925, the vision was to see funding evenly distributed between the state and national conventions. In recent years, N.C. Baptists have taken deliberate steps to increase funding to achieve this 50/50 split, and this year we have the possibility to realize the vision set forth a century ago.

This booklet contains more details and information about the budget that will be recommended during our meeting. After much prayer, discussion and deliberation, this proposal has been affirmed by the budget committee, the executive committee and the board of directors.

N.C. Baptists are fueled by churches, for churches. It is because of your generosity and partnership that we are able to bring the gospel to our state and to the nations. I am so encouraged to see how God is moving through our churches, and I am excited to see what lies ahead.

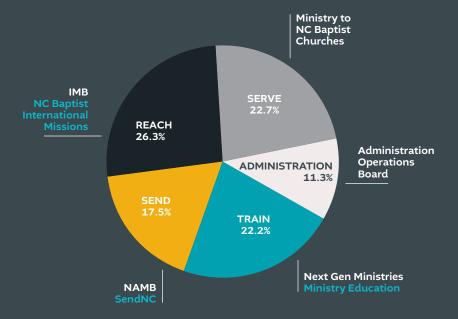
