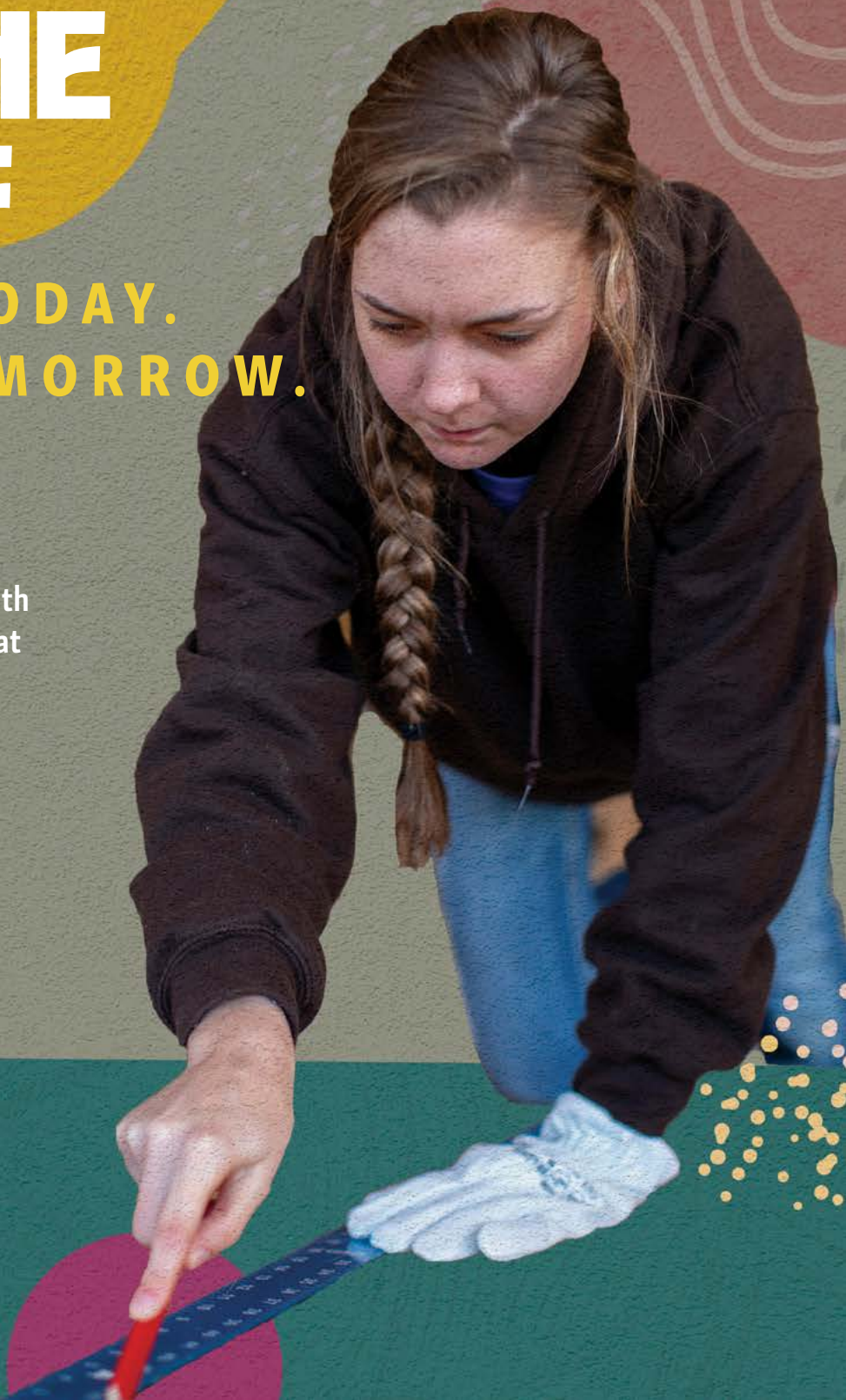

Thank you for your prayers and gifts as we seek to meet this year’s offering goal of \$2.6 million.

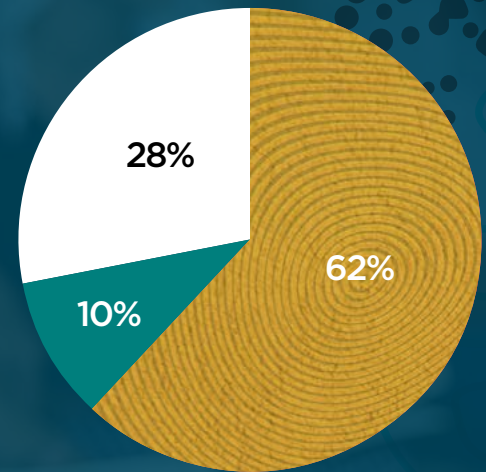

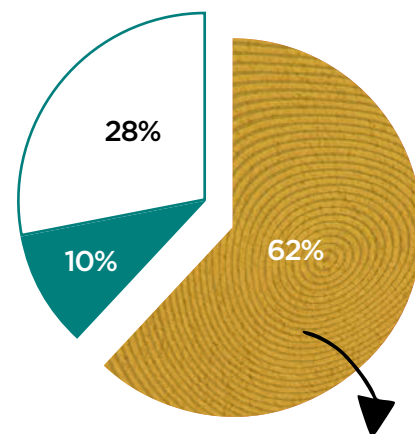
“Relief for today. Hope for tomorrow.” is the theme for this year’s North Carolina Missions Offering (NCMO).



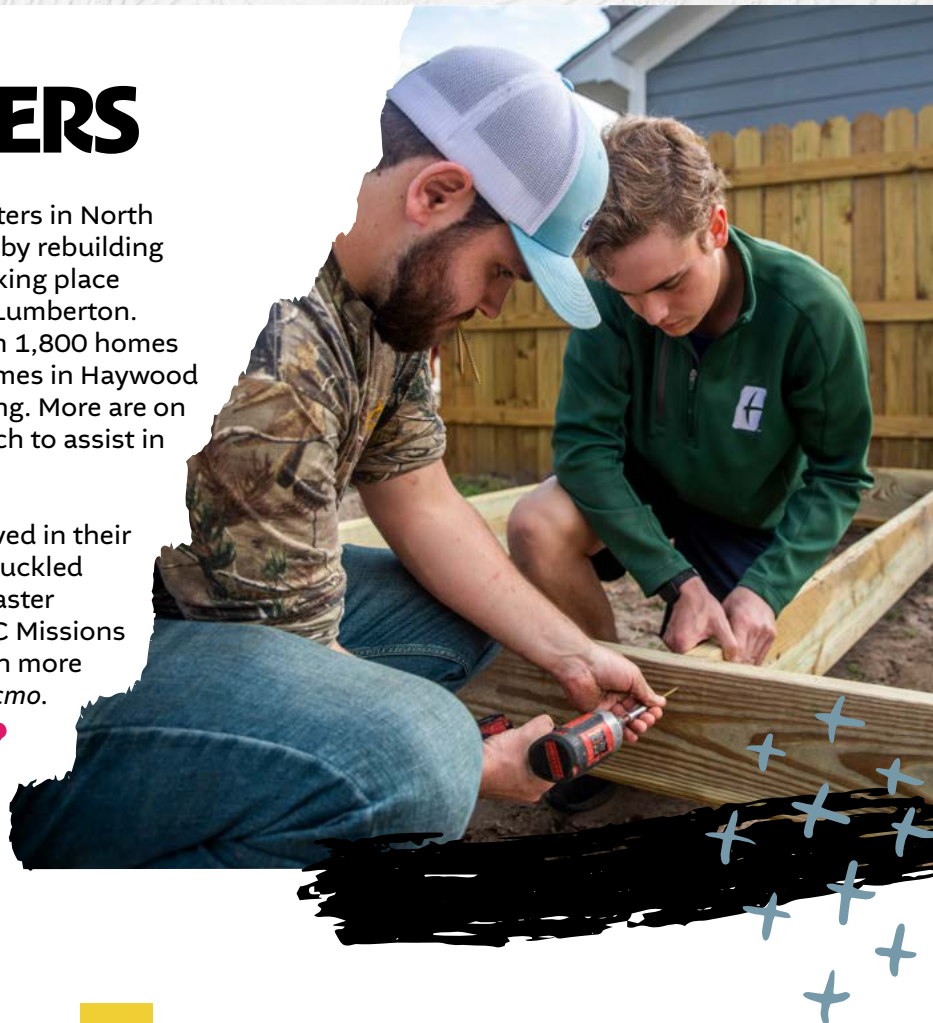

REBUILD CENTERS

Baptists on Mission operate four rebuild centers in North Carolina, where volunteers help restore lives by rebuilding homes after a disaster. Rebuild efforts are taking place in Haywood County, Charity, New Bern and Lumberton. Volunteers have already worked in more than 1,800 homes damaged by Hurricane Florence and 150 homes in Haywood County following Tropical Storm Fred flooding. More are on the waiting list. Consider bringing your church to assist in rebuilding lives and offering hope.

After Hurricane Florence, the Butler family lived in their house for five years with mold, mildew and buckled floors. Thanks to the help of N.C Baptist Disaster Response volunteers and your gifts to the NC Missions Offering, they're now in a new home. MEDICAL, DENTAL AND HEALTH SCREENING MINISTRIES

A fleet of mobile medical, dental and health screening units offer free health services to underserved patients. The fleet is staffed by volunteer medical and dental professionals. All patients who receive treatment also hear the good news of Jesus Christ from pastors and volunteers who provide care.

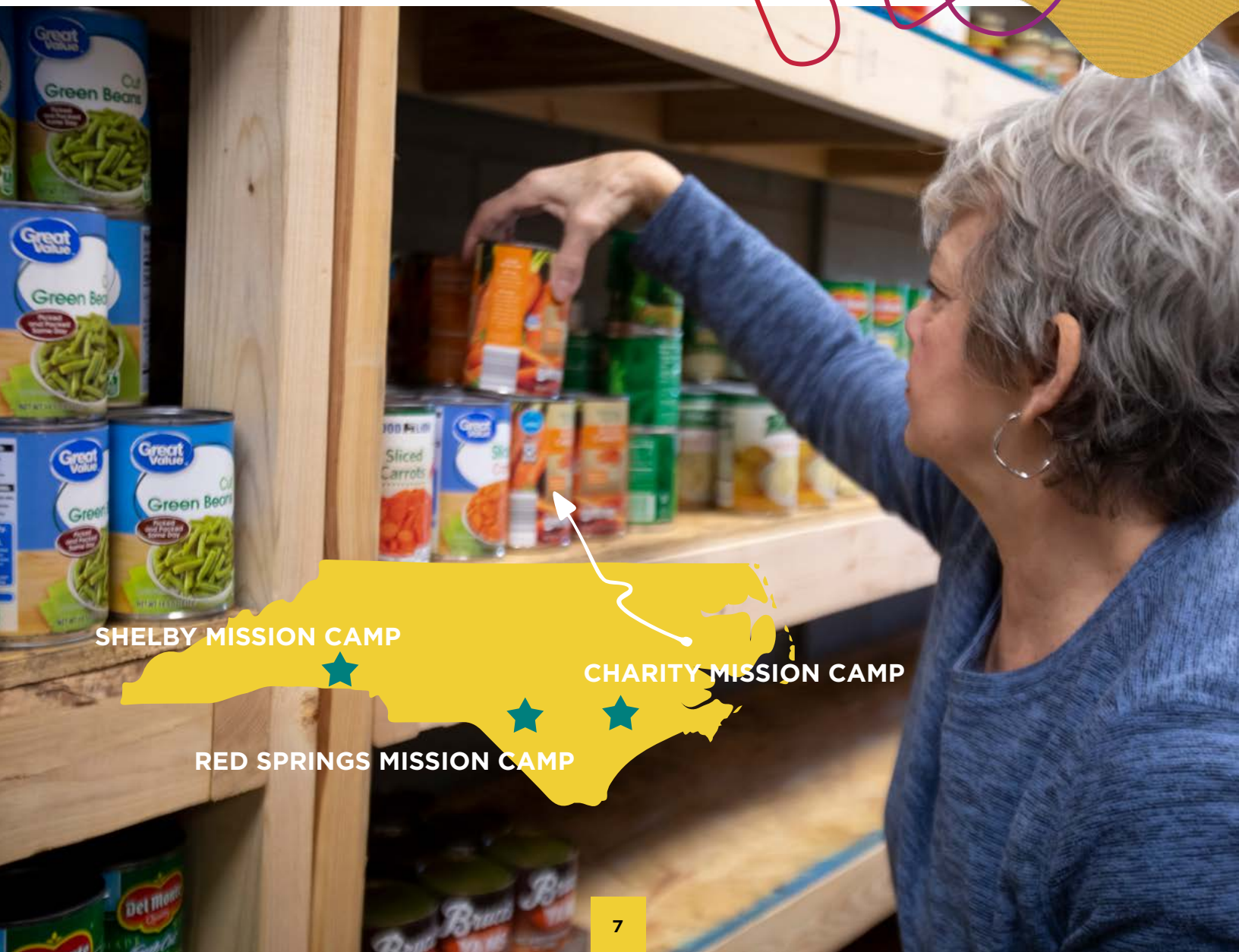
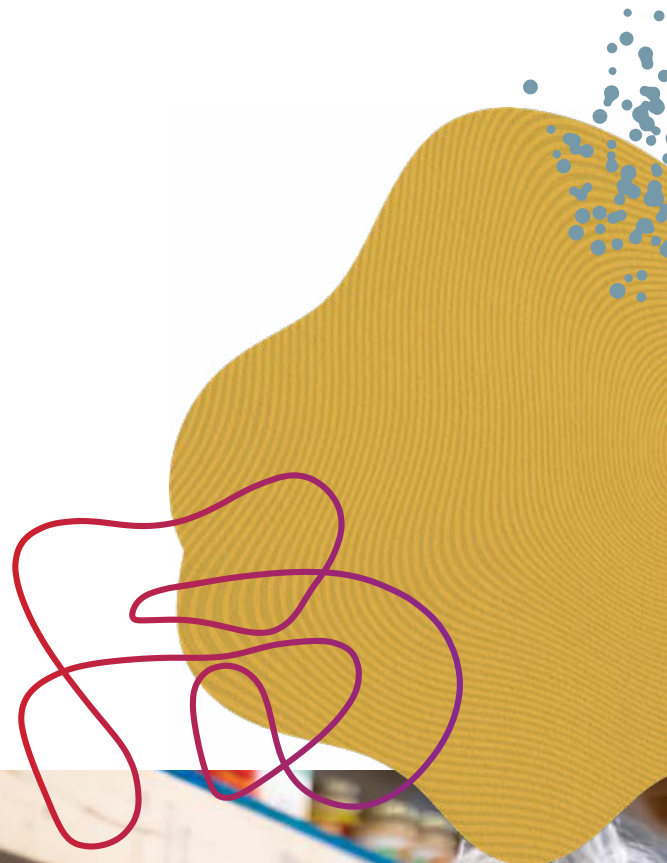

MISSION CAMPS

Baptists on Mission operates mission camps in Red Springs, Shelby and Rose Hill that help churches get involved in missions. The camps host churches, youth groups and others and coordinate short-term missions projects in the local community. Volunteers engage in a variety of projects, which include construction, painting, home repair, yard work, Bible schools, sports camps and more.

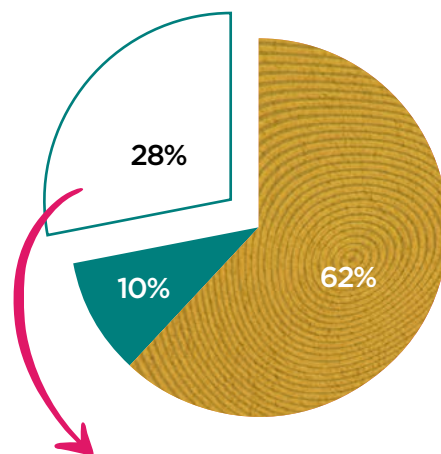


A CHURCH PLANTING PARTNERSHIP

In September 2022, N.C. Baptists joined forces with the North American Mission Board to launch SendNC, a collaborative partnership that seeks to catalyze a church planting movement in cities and towns from the mountains to the coast.

SendNC works with churches, associations and church-planting networks to facilitate the launch of new churches, all with the goal of reaching the unreached in North Carolina and beyond.

The North Carolina Missions Offering is vital to SendNC's church planting efforts, as it provides approximately one-third of SendNC's annual budget. This year, 28% of NCMO gifts will go toward planting new churches in North Carolina. Your support is foundational to this mission.

WHAT'S NEXT FOR SendNC?

In 2023, N.C. Baptists saw 29 church planters endorsed and 50 new churches join our movement of churches.

Many churches across the state are struggling. Statistics repeatedly demonstrate the need for widespread revitalization of existing churches. With approximately 4,300 Baptist churches in North Carolina, some may wonder why planting new churches is necessary. However, new church plants are one of the most effective ways to reach new people with the gospel of Jesus Christ and to breathe new missional life into existing churches.

SendNC continues to catalyze new sending churches and church planting residencies in existing churches, hosting workshops and church planter assessment events.

God's plan for a church is multiplication. Strengthening existing churches should — and will — result in new churches. Every single church that is currently in need of revitalization was, at one time, a church plant. Our desire is to have those churches rediscover the vision for church planting and multiplication.

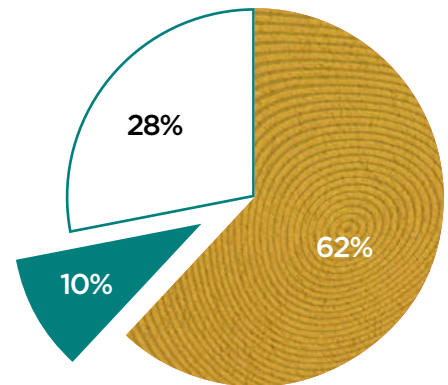
ASSOCIATIONS

WEEK OF PRAYER

FOR THE NORTH CAROLINA MISSIONS OFFERING

SEPT. 1-8

The month of September marks the primary emphasis for the North Carolina Missions Offering. Please join in a special prayer emphasis for NCMO and ministries it supports in the week leading into September. Following are some suggested daily prayer points for individuals and churches.

SUNDAY, SEPT. 1

Baptists on Mission

Pray for the leaders of Baptists on Mission and for guidance for the 19 ministries Baptists on Mission support. Ask God to use those involved to make disciples of Jesus. Pray for churches to raise up volunteers who minister through national and international partnerships.

MONDAY, SEPT. 2

Church planters and church plants across North Carolina

Pray for wisdom and blessing on church planters. Ask God to raise up more planters and draw people to Him through new churches.

TUESDAY, SEPT. 3

Disaster relief

Thank God for the work of disaster relief volunteers. Ask for His blessings on the volunteers as they show and share Jesus' love with people in need.

WEDNESDAY, SEPT. 4

Mission Camps in Red Springs and Shelby

Pray for the directors and volunteers of the mission camps in Red Springs and Shelby. Pray for their safety and direction as they serve residents of these communities.

THURSDAY, SEPT. 5

Church planting consultants

Ask the Lord to guide N.C. Baptist church planting consultants who help recruit, train and encourage church planters across our state.

FRIDAY, SEPT. 6

Baptist associations

Pray for associational missions strategists and their teams as they serve local congregations. Ask God to help them reach their communities for Christ by strengthening churches, sharing the gospel and making disciples.

SATURDAY, SEPT. 7

Medical, Dental, Health Ministry

Ask God to meet the physical and spiritual needs of those served through medical, dental and health screening ministries. Pray for patients to meet Jesus and know His love. Thank Him for the medical professionals, pastors and counselors who volunteer their time to bring physical and spiritual help to the hurting.

SUNDAY, SEPT. 8

Church planting among internationals

Pray that God would raise up more laborers for local and international missions, and more churches to serve their communities and send members internationally. Ask Him to draw people to Jesus through churches, especially in ethnically diverse areas.
