SOUTHWESTERN BAPTIST THEOLOGICAL SEMINARY | EAST ASIA

*Jeremiah and *Joy Farmer have been missionaries in East Asia for 15 years. Because they serve in a dangerous area, their names have been hidden for safety reasons. Our church supports them through our Cooperative Program giving.

When the Farmers were called to East Asia, the population in their area consisted of over 650 million people and 80% of them had never heard of Jesus. The Farmers were overwhelmed with where to start. To prepare, Jeremiah attended Southwestern Baptist Theological Seminary in Fort Worth, Texas. This is one of the six seminaries our church supports through the Cooperative Program.

Over the last 15 years, Jeremiah and Joy have seen more than 700 churches planted. The gospel has been shared with 2.5 million people, and 45,000 people have come to faith in Christ. In addition, more than 2,500 leaders have been trained as disciple-makers. Thanks to the grace of God, the Farmers have come a long way from where they started, but there is still much to be done among the people of East Asia.

Now, let's pray together and thank God for the Farmers. Thank Him for the ways the Cooperative Program has enabled them to learn and serve. Let's ask for more missionaries to leverage their lives to go and share the good news of Jesus Christ.
