But at one office park, banners are flying, cars are arriving and it's plain that something is happening here.

The church planter's name is Sergio (say SERGE-ee-oh) Fesiuk (say fez-OOK). Sergio's name is not quite like Smith or Jones, because he was born in Ukraine, though he grew up here.

For years he was in a church for Eastern Europeans, but then God called him to start a church and he did. Audaci Church was started several years ago and has grown steadily.

That means the members are impacting a pocket of lostness, an area of south Asheville/Arden, where the numbers of non-Christians are especially high.

So today let us pray for our missionary Sergio, his wife, Mariya, and their four children. And let us pray that this new church will grow and reach thousands in the Arden-Asheville-Hendersonville area with the gospel of Jesus Christ.
