Today we want to pray for one of our church planters who is starting a church over in the mountains of western North Carolina.

His name is Trent Holbert. He and his musician wife started a new church in Kentucky several years ago, but then sensed God calling them to the Black Mountain/Ridgecrest area, just east of Asheville.

The area has become famous for its hippies, Eastern-focused religion and the like, but that's not all bad, Trent says. There's a lot of spirituality, he says, but the people are lost because they do not know Jesus Christ as Savior.

People will talk, though, because they are spiritually hungry. Through Passion Fellowship Church, he hopes to talk to people in ways they will understand. He has a good beginning, since as a fitness coach he knows about herbs and essential oils. He knows about meditation, but the God-focused and Bible-directed kind.

Our church is supporting Trent in this new work because part of our Cooperative Program helps start new churches all over North Carolina at a rate of a new church about every five days.

Since Trent is "our" missionary, let's pray for him and his new church now.
