William and his family have moved into an area where there are many Asian Indians and have begun making friends and getting to know them so they can more easily share the gospel.

Our church is supporting William through our Cooperative Program giving. We need many more missionaries like him because there are so many Asian Indians now living in this part of our state and they desperately need to be saved.

Let us pray today that William will have wisdom and understanding, that through him many will come to know Jesus Christ in a personal, saving way.
