The Raleigh-Durham-Chapel Hill area, also known as the Triangle, exercises significant influence throughout North Carolina as a leader in government, education and technology. The Triangle attracts a growing number of companies involved in technology, as well as medical research and development. Anchored by leading research universities, the area is fast-growing and diverse. Population density is increasing as numerous apartment complexes and subdivisions are constructed each year throughout the greater Triangle. Outlying towns feel the impact as they become bedroom communities for those working in the Triangle. Residents with lower incomes are facing greater difficulty in securing housing, most often residing in older, run-down apartment complexes with all the accompanying social ills. The Triangle has attracted large numbers of internationals — students, professionals, construction workers and refugees. The high degree of diversity in socioeconomic status, jobs/professions, race, ethnicity, educational achievement, and interests gives the church the challenge and opportunity to engage people in many different ways to impact lostness through disciple-making.
