Early in his career he became noted for his work in conducting and teaching children and youth, and he is excited to continue those pursuits while working with children of all ages! He is a tireless champion for performance arts in both the classroom and the community.

Recently retiring after a career spanning over thirty years of public school music education in southern West Virginia, Tim has more time to pursue other facets of music-making! When not on the road conducting or teaching at one of his festivals and workshops a year, or composing and writing from his studio, he has served as Artist-in-Residence and Director of Music for churches in WV. Tim has been associated professionally with church music as a career since his youth.

He serves as Founding Conductor and Artistic Director for *Charlotte Bronze Handbell Ensemble* for the eleven years of its existence.

Tim has had the honor to perform, teach, and conduct on four continents in 12 countries, including England, Scotland, Ireland, Hong Kong (China), and in Caracas Venezuela for El Systema.

His compositions of liturgical, choral, organ and handbell music are published in the US by nine publishers and have been played across the world and in outer space! He is often commissioned to write new compositions for events and festivals.
